ORDINANCE NO. 297

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AURORA,

SOUTH DAKOTA PERTAINING TO PROHIBITED PARKING DURING SNOW FALL OF 2" OR MORE OR DURING THE

REMOVAL OF SNOW IN THE CITY OF AURORA, SOUTH DAKOTA.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF AURORA,
SOUTH DAKOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

I.

Sec. 1. - Parking prohibited with snow fall of 2" or more or during snow removal.

It is unlawful for the driver or owner of any motor vehicle, trailer or implement to park or leave standing or permit to be parked or left standing any motor vehicle, trailer or implement on any street, avenue or alley in the city, after a snow fall of 2" or more or during snow removal by the City of Aurora. Parking may not be resumed until such streets have been cleared of such snow from curb to curb.

Sec. 2. - Parking during state of emergency.

(a) It is unlawful for the driver or owner of any motor vehicle, trailer or implement to park or leave standing or permit to be parked or left standing any motor vehicle, trailer or implement on any street or alley in the city when a state of emergency has been declared in the city. (b) A state of emergency shall exist when the mayor or city administrator or designee shall declare an emergency. The mayor or city administrator or designee may, in the event of threatening or existing adverse weather or street conditions, declare a state of emergency in the city and prohibit parking on streets which are otherwise regulated in this chapter for a period of 72 hours or until a particular street has been cleaned from curb to curb.
