## Ordinance No. 345

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AURORA, SOUTH DAKOTA AND PERTAINING TO DEPOSITS IN RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF AURORA, SOUTH DAKOTA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of Aurora, South Dakota as follows:

T

Duty to Remove. It shall be the duty of the owner, tenant, or person in possession of any property abutting on any sidewalk to keep such sidewalk and boulevard free from snow and to cause any accumulated snow to be removed within forty-eight (48) hours after the termination of any snowfall, or snow accumulation.

II.

Disposal of snow. It shall be the duty of the property owner, tenant, or person in possession of any public or private driveway, parking lot or parking area or boulevard to dispose of accumulated snow upon such property in such manner that any snow when removed shall not be deposited upon any sidewalk or within or upon any public street or alley, or in a manner that will obstruct or interfere with the passage or vision of vehicles or pedestrian traffic. Such conduct or action is declared to be a nuisance. This, however, does not prohibit the placement of snow from a sidewalk in the curb area of the street where no boulevard or other property exists to place snow from the sidewalks in the Broadway business district.

III

Removal Costs Assessed. In the event any owner, tenant, or person in possession of any property shall neglect or fail to or refuse to remove snow or ice from a sidewalk within the time provided, or any owner, tenant, or person in possession of any property shall deposit snow upon any sidewalk or public street or alley, the City may issue a citation for such violation and fine and may remove such snow, with the costs assessed against the property owner.

Any or all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
