ORDINANCE NO. 280 CITY OF AURORA

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ALL OTHERS PERTAINING TO VOTING WARDS AND ADOPTING NEW ORDINANCE DIVIDING THE CITY OF AURORA INTO TWO (2) WARDS AND ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF AURORA, SOUTH DAKOTA:

Wards and Voting Precincts. The City shall be divided into two (2) wards, which shall be combined and consolidated into one election precinct, and shall be designated respectively as Wards One and Two. The wards shall be described by setting for the certain street or avenue designations or other landmarks that divide and border the wards. Any reference to street or avenue below shall mean an imaginary line running down the approximate middle of each street or avenue. The wards of the City of Aurora are as set forth below and the map thereof. Any discrepancies shall be resolved by reference to the map rather than the physical descriptions set forth herein. A map illustrating the boundaries and location of each ward is kept on file with the Finance Officer at City Hall.

First Ward will encompass that portion of the City lying within the following described boundaries:

All that portion of the City lying west of the center line of Broadway Avenue at the north boundary of City Limits to its intersection with Front Street; and all that portion of the City lying south of the center line of Front Street from its intersection with Broadway Avenue and Madison Avenue; and all that portion of the City south of the center line of Rasmussen Street from its intersection with Madison Avenue to the east boundary of City Limits.

Second Ward will encompass that portion of the City lying within the following described boundaries:

All that portion of the City lying east of the center line of Broadway Avenue at the north boundary of City Limits to its intersection with Front Street; and all that portion of the City lying north of the center line of Front Street from its intersection with Broadway Avenue and Madison Avenue; and all that portion of the City north of the center line of Rasmussen Street from its intersection with Madison Avenue to the east boundary of City Limits.

All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect twenty (20) days from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
