Ordinance No. 299

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AURORA, SOUTH DAKOTA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Aurora as follows:

I.

Sec. 1. Fines for Municipal Ordinance Violations.

A. <u>Maximum Fine</u>. Except as otherwise provided by law or ordinance, a person convicted of a violation of the ordinances of the City of Aurora shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200.00. A violation of this Code is not punishable by imprisonment in a county jail. Except as otherwise provided by law or ordinance:

- (1) With respect to violations of this Code that are continuous with respect to time, each day that the violation continues is a separate offense.
- (2) With respect to violations of this Code that are not continuous with respect to time, each act is a separate offense.
- B. <u>Fine Resolution</u>. The fines for violations of city ordinances shall, from time to time, be established by Resolution of the City Council. The Schedule of Fines shall be effective following approval by the City Council.
