Ordinance No. 331

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ALL OTHERS PERTAINING TO VOTING WARDS AND ADOPTING A NEW ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW BOUNDARIES OF THE TWO (2) VOTING WARDS OF THE CITY OF AURORA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Aurora as follows:

I.

Wards and Voting Precincts. The City shall be divided into two (2) Wards, which shall be combined and consolidated into one election precinct, and shall be designated respectively as Wards One and Two. The Wards shall be described by setting forth the certain street or avenue designations or other landmarks that divide and border the Wards. Any reference to street or avenue below shall mean an imaginary line running down the approximate middle of each street or avenue. The Wards of the City of Aurora are as set forth below and the map thereof is attached. Any discrepancies shall be resolved by reference to the map rather than the physical descriptions set forth herein. A map illustrating the boundaries and location of each Ward is also kept on file with the Finance Officer at the Aurora City Hall.

The First Ward encompasses that portion of the City lying within the following described boundaries:

- a. All that portion of the City lying west of the center line of Broadway Avenue at the north boundary of City Limits to the south boundary of the City limits; and
- b. All that portion of the City lying south of the center line of East Pine Street from its intersection with Broadway Avenue to the intersection of East Pine Street and Madison Avenue and south to the south boundary of the City; and
- c. All that portion of the City south of the center line of Rasmussen Street from its intersection with Madison Avenue to the east boundary of the City limits and south to the south boundary line of the City.

The Second Ward encompasses that portion of the City lying within the following described boundaries:

- a. All that portion of the City lying east of the center line of Broadway Avenue at the north boundary of City Limits to its intersection with East Pine Street, and to the east boundary of the City limits; and
- b. All that portion of the City lying south of the center line of East Pine Street from its intersection with Madison Avenue to the east City limits and south to the center line of Rasmussen Street at its intersection with Madison Avenue to the east boundary of the City limits.

II.

Any or all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect twenty (20) days from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
