RESOLUTION 07-05

A RESOLUTION VACATING PLATTED STREET BETWEEN LOT 7 OF BLOCK 2 IN KIRBY ADDITION
AND LOT 4 IN RAILROAD ADDITION WEST OF KIRBY STREET, IN THE
KIRBY ADDITION IN THE CITY OF AURORA, SOUTH DAKOTA

WHEREAS, a said platted street between lot 7 of block 2 in Kirby Addition and lot 4 in Railroad Addition west of Kirby Street, in the Kirby Addition in the City of Aurora, Brookings County, South Dakota was recorded in the Brookings County Register of Deeds Office on December 31, 1966 in Book Eight (8) of Plats, page 5 at 9:00 a.m., and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has been petitioned by the landowner of all property abutting upon both sides to that portion of said platted street to vacate said street as set forth in SDCL 9-45-10, and has been verified by the affidavit of such owner/owners, and

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing has been published once each week for two successive weeks, and such hearing took place not less than thirty days from the date of the first publication of such notice, and

WHEREAS, the said platted street has not been used, worked or traveled as such during twenty years next preceding the time of the meeting and since the recording of the plat thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Aurora, South Dakota that said platted street between lot 7 of block 2 in Kirby Addition and lot 4 in Railroad Addition west of Kirby Street, in the Kirby Addition in the City of Aurora, Brookings County, South Dakota be declared vacated, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacated street shall be divided between the abutting landowners of record, each receiving a parcel 33' wide and the length running directly adjacent to and abutting their property.
