RESOLUTION NO. 23-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF AURORA, SD, ADOPTING AN INTERCONNECTION PROCESS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR QUALIFYING FACILITIES TO IMPLEMENT CO- GENERATION OF ELECTRICITY AND SMALL POWER PRODUCTION FACILITIES UNDER SECTIONS 201 AND 210 OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY REGULATORY POLICIES ACT (PURPA) AND PART 292 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Sections 201 and 210 of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act (PURPA) and Part 292 of the Code of Federal Regulation (hereinafter "federal law and regulation") establish obligations of electric utilities to purchase energy and capacity from qualifying facilities, sell energy and capacity requested by qualifying facilities, make interconnection with qualifying facilities to accomplish purchases or sales, and offer to operate in parallel with qualifying facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City is obligated by federal law and regulation to allow qualifying facilities to interconnect with the City's electrical distribution system and to operate in parallel with qualifying facilities as may be necessary to accomplish purchases from or sales to said qualifying facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to establish process and requirements that ensure qualifying facilities are able to interconnect with the City's electric distribution system, and operate in parallel therewith, in a safe and reliable manner;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF AURORA, SD: That the City of Aurora adopts the attached Interconnection Process and Requirements for Qualifying Facilities under Sections 201 and 210 of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 and Part 292 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which is by reference made part hereof.

That the City shall publish this resolution without attachment after its passage. The attachment is on file and available in the office of the City Finance Officer.
